

### CCSA's MISSION

### STAFF

CCSA is staffed primarily by unpaid volunteers. The agency has only three paid employees covering both centers.

CCSA strives to deliver quality services to its clients at the lowest possible cost. Volunteer services and substantial donations of food, clothing, and supplies, enable CCSA to ensure that overhead is kept low and resources are spent primarily for the benefit of the clients.

### SUPPORT

CCSA is an IRS qualified non-profit organization. All donations are tax-deductible. Over 97 percent of all monies received by CCSA is spent on programs directly benefitting CCSA's clients.

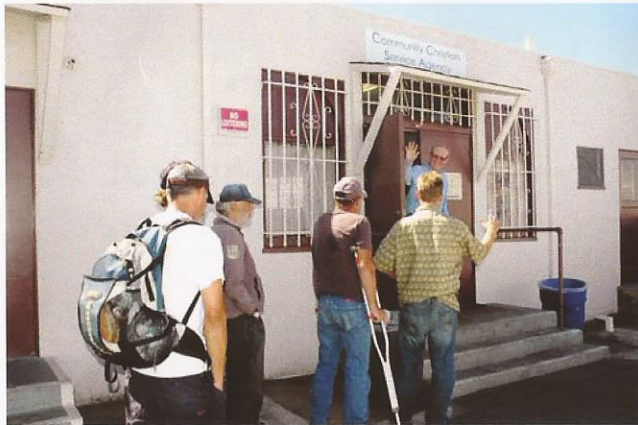

## DAILY SERVICES

The Clairemont Center each month provides food, clothing, and hygiene items to approximately 300 households (cumulatively 800 people).

Homeless individuals make more than 500 visits per month to the Pacific Beach Center. Clients are given food packets, clothing and hygiene items. This center also has a nursing clinic offering first aid, health education and referrals for health services.

Both centers provide transportation assistance in the form of one day bus passes for medical appointments and employment searches. The centers also provide financial aid to help people obtain their birth certificates, California identification cards and prescription medicines and for other emergency needs when deemed appropriate by the agency.

All clients visiting CCSA's two centers are offered resource counseling along with referrals for additional food, shelter, medical care and employment assistance. CCSA also helps clients complete applications for food stamps and other government aid.

Each center is open five-days a week and serves clients on a walk-in basis. All persons are offered service regardless of sex, race, religion or nationality.
